### **Brief Summary –**

The police report, autopsy report of the victim, a relevant newspaper article and pictures of the evidence collected from the crime scene were handed over to the remaining three teams. In this segment, there was individual participation from the members. After thorough study and analysis of the case, each participant asked questions to the murder suspects in investigation round. Based on the answers, they received and their insight on the case, three participants - Mehmoona, Harshitha and Nithya figured out who the murderer was. As a tiebreaker, the three of them were given a crossword. The winner and runner ups were decided based on the points they scored in the final round. Nithya B.A. from final year, PBZ bagged the first place. Harshitha Bharat, outgoing president of the Literary Mavens club won the second place and Mehmoona Masroor Ahmed secured the third place. In a nutshell, this event was successful thanks to the creativity and hard work of the office bearers who came up with an intriguing murder mystery and the enthusiastic participants who took part in it with sheer zeal and joy.
