The contestants were allowed to explain the purpose of their candidature. On 8/11/2022 open canvassing happened.

On 9<sup>th</sup> November 2022 two booths were constituted with Observer, Micro observer, Presiding Officer, Polling Officers 1& 2. All the booths were provided with Electronic Voting Machines (EVM) brought from Bharath Electronic Limited, Bangalore for the post of President, Vice President,

General Secretary, Joint Secretary and Student welfare coordinator. All the NCC Cadets were controlling the Booths for the student's entry.

The election was carried out in a fair and free manner on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2022 from 9:00 am to 1:00pm. All the students were verified with their Identity card and signature taken by respective teacher. The students were marked on their left index figure and allowed to cast their vote. The voting turnout was 74% Students.
