

(hereinafter called the 'Trustees') which expression shall whenever the context so requires or permits mean and include the Trustees for the time being and their successors in office of the OTHER PART;

1. WHEREAS the Hindu Religious Association was formed on 5th September, 1964 with the objects of promoting education and establishing educational Institutions.

2. WHEREAS Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women was established on 8th December, 1968 at Malleswaram, Bangalore - 3 under the auspicious of the above association.

WHEREAS the Hindu Religious Association was dissolved on 24th November, 1974 by the General Body after constituting a Governing Council consisting the present Settlers who are Patrons, Group Representatives and Ex-officio Members.

3. WHEREAS accordingly the Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women vests in the said Governing Council which now consists of the Settlers

IRREVOCABLE AND AMENDMENTS TO THE TRUST

29. The Trust hereby created is irrevocable.

The provisions hereof may be amended if the Board of Trustees unanimously or by not less than three-fourths majority, so decide.

Provided that the character of this Trust as a public charitable Trust, established for the promotion of the objects herein before set forth shall not be altered materially.

It is hereby made clear that the Board of Trustees shall have power to make from time to time all such amendments as may be required to secure recognition, exemptions and reliefs under the Income Tax or other fiscal laws.

30. In the event of dissolution or winding up the Trust the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees/Members of the Managing Committee/other Committee, but the same shall be transferred to another charitable Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.

"That the funds of the Trust shall be invested in the modes stipulated in section 13(1)(d) read with section 11 of the Income Tax Act of 1961"

This clause shall be deemed to have come into force retrospectively from fourth day of January Nineteen Seventy Nine (4.1.1979).

INDEMNITY

28. The Trustees shall be kept indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any action claim, demand or liability arising against them for anything done by them in good faith, pursuant to the Power and authority vested in them under these presents.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :

CREATION OF TRUST

4. Accordingly these presents witness that the Settlers abovenamed hereby create a Trust by the name of 'MAHARANI LAKSHMI AMMANNI COLLEGE TRUST' with the objects and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned.

5. The Settlers hereby transfer unto the Trustees :

- a) All the right, title and interest held by them in the immovable property described in the Schedule written hereunder, which has been granted to the said College by the Government of Karnataka upon lease as per G.O. No. ED 5 SXM 78 dated 26.4.78 and as per Registered lease Deed dated 25.5.78.

- b) The Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women, Bangalore, as a going Institution with all its assets and liabilities, the benefits of all contracts, engagements and services of all existing Staff and Teachers thereof.

6. The Settlers have this day delivered and the Trustees have taken Possession of all the properties and Institution hereby transferred to the Trust.

7. The Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women as also the Schedule Property and any other properties, movable or immovable, securities or monies which the Trustees may hereafter receive or acquire for the Trust, and all additions, accretions and income therefrom and every part thereof shall stand vested in the Trustees upon Trust, subject to the provisions hereof.

NATURE OF TRUST

8. This shall be a public charitable trust having no profit motive. The properties and income of the Trust shall be applied in India solely towards the promotion of the objects for which this Trust is created, without any discrimination on grounds of caste, religion, race or sex.

OFFICE OF THE TRUST

9. The Principal Office of the Trust shall be located at No. 63/5, 3rd Main Road, Malleswaram, Bangalore - 3, or at such other place in the City of Bangalore as the Trustees may determine from time to time.

FRAMING OF RULES AND BYE-LAWS

26. The Board of Trustees may frame Rules and Bye-laws amend or rescind them as they deem fit for the management of the Trust, the administration of its institutions, properties and the proceedings of the Trustees, and its Committees.

ACCOUNTS

27. The Board of Trustees and Managing Committee shall duly maintain true and correct accounts of all assets, disposals, receipts and expenses of the Trust and a correct record of the meetings and deliberations. A general meeting of the Trustees shall be held once at least in every year at which the accounts of the Trust hereby constituted and a report concerning the same to be prepared by such person or persons and in such manner as the Trustees, shall direct, shall be presented.

do all such other acts and things as may be delegated to it by the Board of Trustees.

The Managing Committee shall be constituted once in every three years, at the beginning of every calendar year. The 1st Managing Committee shall however remain in office till the beginning of the year 1982 or till a new Committee is constituted in that year.

25. Without prejudice to the powers of the Managing Committee, the Board of Trustees may from time to time

OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

10. The objects of the Trust are :

- i) To spread, promote and foster education or learning in all its branches;
- ii) To establish and maintain or assist in establishing and maintaining colleges, schools, Study Centres, Libraries, Reading Rooms for the promotion, instruction and diffusion of knowledge in all spheres;
- iii) To pay school and college fees and establish scholarships and otherwise assist poor and deserving boys and girls, pursue their education;
- iv) To establish and maintain or assist in establishing and maintaining and supporting Hostels and/or Boarding Houses and give grants for free Boarding and lodging to poor and deserving students; and
- v) To administer Maharani Lakshmi Ammamni College for Women already established;

TRUSTEES

11. Every person appointed as new Trustee shall be a citizen of India and shall ordinarily be resident within a radius of one hundred and fifty kilometres from the Principal Office of the Trust.

The Chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote in the event of equality of votes at a meeting.

The business of the Trust may also be transacted by circulation of papers.

VACANCIES

12. If and so often as the Trustees or any of them or any Trustee appointed under this provision or any statutory power shall die or desire to be discharged from or refuse or neglect or become incapable or unfit to act, the surviving or continuing Trustees or Trustee, for the time being, (and for this purpose any retiring or refusing Trustee shall if willing to act in the execution of this power, be considered a continuing Trustee), may and, whenever the number shall be reduced to less than seven, shall appoint new Trustees or a new Trustee to the vacancy so created. This power shall be additional to and shall not prevent the execution or exercise of any statutory power to appoint new Trustees for the time being in force.

POWERS OF TRUSTEES

13. The Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, its institutions, properties and funds

23. There shall be a Managing Committee for the Trust. It shall consist of not more than 7 (Seven) members. The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Trust shall be ex-officio members of the Committee. Three others shall be elected by and from amongst the Trustees.

Subject to any General or Special directions given by the Board of Trustees and subject to ultimate control by the Board of Trustees, the Managing Committee shall be incharge of the day-to-day administration of the affairs, Institutions, Properties and funds of the Trust and shall exercise all powers and discharge all functions necessary or incidental thereto including the sanction of payment of such stipends and scholarships as are in conformity with the relevant Rules and Bye-laws of the Trust. The Managing Committee shall also have power to exercise and

herein before mentioned as to their term of office.

19. Secretary : There shall be a Secretary to the Trust. The Trustees may either elect him from amongst themselves, so, however, that the same person shall not hold two elective offices or employ him for such period and on such terms as the Trustees may decide. A Trustee elected as Secretary shall not be entitled to any salary. The first Secretary is Dr. K.N.V. Sastri.

20. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to summon under the instructions of the Chairman meetings of the Board of Trustees and the Managing Committee and to enter minutes of all the proceedings of such meetings in a Minute Book and the same shall be signed by the Chairman on confirmation.

21. The quorum required for a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be five. In the case of a meeting adjourned for want of quorum the members present shall themselves constitute the quorum.

22. All decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be taken by a simple majority except as expressly provided otherwise herein.

and to do all acts, deeds and things as are calculated to promote the objects for which this Trust is created. They shall be entitled to act even if their number is reduced to less than seven for the purpose of filling up any vacancies on the Board of Trustees.

14. No vacancy in the Board of Trustees and no irregularity in the appointment of Trustees shall invalidate any act or decision of the Board of Trustees.

15. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the Trustees shall have power for the purposes of this Trust:

- a) to acquire, hold and dispose of properties immovable, movable, stocks, securities and shares, etc.
- b) to sell, mortgage, grant on lease, hire or otherwise alienate the properties of the Trust,
- c) to borrow monies with or without security and to repay the same,
- d) to enter into all contracts, vary and rescind them,
- e) to open Bank Accounts and pro-

vide for operation thereon, as the Trustees may deem fit from time to time,

- f) to invest the funds of the Trust not immediately required for the purposes of the Trust in such manner as they deem fit,
- g) to receive gifts, grants, donations in cash or kind,
- h) to establish scholarships tenable at the College,
- i) to institute, prosecute and demand all suits, legal and other proceedings,
- j) to appear and act before Courts, Tribunals, Governmental, Tax and other public Authorities,
- k) to appoint, terminate, dismiss, suspend and otherwise deal with the employees of the Trust and its Institutions,
- l) to apply the properties and funds of the Trust for all or any of the objects for which the Trust is established, as may be determined by the Board of Trustees from time to time,
- m) to incur all necessary expenses connected with the Trust.

PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT AND TREASURER TO BE ELECTED

- 16. Once in every three years, the Trustees shall elect three among themselves to be a President, a Vice-President, and a Treasurer. In the event of a vacancy in any of these offices caused by death, resignation or otherwise, then a new person shall be elected in the same manner and shall hold office for three years from that date. The President of the Trust shall preside at all the meetings of the Board of Trustees and the Managing Committee. In his absence or inability, the Vice-President or failing him any one of the members elected from among those present shall be the Chairman of the meeting. The first President, Vice-President and Treasurer are those named in para 24 below.
- 17. The Treasurer shall be responsible for keeping the Accounts of the Trust and to get them audited at least once in every year by such auditors as the Trustees may appoint.
- 18. The Board of Trustees may also assign to these officers such duties and functions as it deems fit. The Officers elected aforesaid shall hold office during the pleasure of the Board of Trustees, notwithstanding anything

LIFE SCIENCES RESEARCH CENTRE - RECOGNIZED BY BANGALORE UNIVERSITY

The Life sciences has the credentials of producing outstanding students in both the undergraduate and post graduate levels. The research lab is a state of art lab with high end equipment to carry out quality life sciences research projects. Faculty members and students of the institution engage in research that has social relevance for the benefit of the community. Teaching staff and students of other institutions are also encouraged to use the facility as an outreach initiative to carry out research in cutting edge areas. The faculty is well trained for advances in modern researches in the various fields of Biosciences such as Neurosciences, Gerontology, Molecular endocrinology, diabetes, antioxidants and free radical studies, Environment biotechnology, Plant biotechnology, Biochemistry, Bioinformatics and Microbiology.

ANIMAL CELL CULTURE FACILITY

The Life sciences department of MLACW maintains a self-contained Cell Culture Facility that houses all equipments needed for the growth, maintenance, and analysis of animal cells. The facility provides basic support to investigators: preparation, filtration and testing of numerous cell culture media. The facility has experience in: a) growing a range of different cell lines b) large scale cell cultures c) transfection of cells and d) culturing mesenchymal stem cells. Moreover, various cell culture training workshops are organized in collaboration with different cell lines institutes.

ANIMAL HOUSE FACILITY

A well maintained animal house facility has CPCSEA approval to carry out experiments involving animals. Good Laboratory Practices (GLP) for animal facilities is intended to assure quality, maintenance and safety of animals used in laboratory studies while conducting biomedical and behavioral research and testing of products. CPCSEA Guidelines are always followed to promote the humane care of animals used in biomedical and behavioral research and testing with the basic objective of providing specifications that will enhance animal well-being, quality in the pursuit of advancement of biological knowledge that is relevant to humans and animals. Further, this animal house facility is also encouraged to be used by other colleges and institutes working in collaboration on different research projects.

PLANT TISSUE CULTURE FACILITY

The Plant Tissue Culture Facility comprised of well-equipped lab working space with Laminar Air Flow and culture room. The culture growth room includes racks with fluorescent lamps fitted with AC and a shaker-cum incubator. The facility operates as a full-service facility delivering cell-culture based training programs for post-graduate Life sciences and engineering students and a high quality space for researchers to use for their own specific project needs.

Services available include cell/ tissue culture of many different plant species, project consultation, training workshops, self-service hood usage and offering high quality growth space. Development of protocols of tissue culture systems such as: *Gymnema*, *Bambo*, *Bacopa*, *Cymbopogon*, *Stevia*, *Eclipta sps* and various different cell cultures have been laid.

STUDY CIRCLE FOR LIFE SCIENCE (SCLS)

This forum with a mission and vision to promote quality in education in science envisages a variety of activities like training faculty members, training students for various National Level Competitive exams for Science students, hands on workshop, seminars by eminent scientists from research institutes and industries, industry academia collaboration, promote networking of faculty members and students involved in research to exchange their ideas for new initiatives.

IIT-JAM COACHING PROGRAM

This program has the objective to cater the IIT aspirants of the PG program in biotechnology, to achieve their goal in premier institutions. The coaching program helped the promising Life science students of MLACW and neighboring colleges to pursue PG studies in research and development career, in frontier areas of basic science and interdisciplinary areas of science and technology.

UGC SPONSORED ADD-ON COURSES

The Under Graduate students are provided with an opportunity to enroll for job oriented add on course that runs along the side of regular program and the focus is on teaching the latest practical skills that are over and above curriculum. The value addition of the program is improvement in the employability.

1. **BIOINFORMATICS** - The Buzzword Bioinformatics was still in budding stage but we took a bold step to introduce Diploma in Bioinformatics. Since 8 years we are conducting this course, students have found biology learning very exciting and all are able to understand and appreciate complex concepts of biology. Bioinformatics as helped to manage the research data, Data analysis and data retrieval. We have a well established Bioinformatics lab with high end systems and servers. With this infrastructure available DBT, Govt. of India has recognized as Bioinformatics Infrastructure Facility. This has enhanced our research work and to publish papers. Recently in the year 2010, the Govt. of Karnataka has sanctioned BT Finishing School to

Bridge the gap between Academia and Industry, we teach two domains Clinical Research & Clinical Data Management and Bioinformatics. The students who complete this Finishing school are placed in the Biotech Industries. The DBT in the academic year 2011-12, the Life Science department has been recognized as STAR STATUS, only two Institutions in the entire Karnataka state have this recognition. One is our college. All the awards are given because we have a strong Bioinformatics facility. In this STAR STATUS recognition the college has been given a financial aid by DBT to strengthen the Life Science departments, the focus is being interdisciplinary. This facility has enabled us to conduct number of Symposiums, Workshops and Training programmes funded by DBT & UGC.

2. **CLINICAL BIO-CHEMISTRY** - This course gives an insight into research. The students are exposed to handle high end equipments. Submission of the project is compulsory. The students have to design the protocol and standardize. The students who complete this course are offered Jobs in Clinical research and Pharmaceutical companies. Some of our students are given a position of the Research Associates in IISC, this has helped the students to prepare for Ph.D and hands on exposure to advanced technology. The faculty members are from M.S Ramaiah Medical Teaching College with whom we have MOU. Students are working with Clinical trials in an organization with Bangalore Endocrinology and Diabetic Research Centre.
3. **DATA CARE MANAGEMENT** - The UNISTAR software and other Free softwares are used in this course. Any students without the knowledge of the computers can pursue this course. It is a Bridge course between the Academia and the industry. Students who had completed Diploma are preferred in the placement. This helps them to expertise in maintaining computers. This course helps in the recovery of the data which has been deleted, loss etc.,
4. **E-COMMERCE** -Students from all the streams can enroll. Majority of the students are from B.Com and BBM course. Students who have completed this course are able to design, host and maintain the website. The students can learn the following, online transaction, electronic funds transfer, supply chain management, internet marketing, electronic data interchange etc.,
5. **ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT:** Every business requires an entrepreneur. An entrepreneur visualizes a business, acquires the various factors required for its commencement and finally makes a start. The diploma course in entrepreneurship prepares a student to become an entrepreneur, thereby providing employment opportunities and contributing to economic growth.
6. **INSURANCE:** The hot footing of pioneering foreign insurance companies in India have created a landmark in India's economy resulting in more

prominent innovative insurance concepts and schemes that widely cover many under served areas.

The course is supported by the Bangalore Chapter of Indian Institute of Insurance whereby the students become Members and later the Fellows of the prestigious Indian Institute of Insurance.

7. **COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH** - Students who wish to improve their English language skills can attend these classes and this will help them to gain confidence. The language lab is set up in the college to make students more proficient in spoken English. The primary focus of this course is to help students to communicate and express themselves better in English, and give them an edge over others in securing good placements. There is a fully equipped computer lab with internet facility. Students can also take online tests on various topics. Extensive learning material comprising of videos, CDs, DVDs and books are available for students.
8. **COMPUTER NETWORKS** - The students who have the knowledge of computers i.e PMC and BCA students are enrolled. The students who pursue this course are placed in 3 to 4 offer letters. The students learn IP (Internet Protocol) in this course. The students also learn to solve any problems in the PC. The designation in the companies who pursue this course is System Administrator. We have a good laboratory. The software used to teach this course is Netsim.
9. **MOLECULAR TECHNIQUES** - This course is designed to benefit students and provide job opportunities in the Industries involved in Vaccine Production, Food technology, Fermentation Technology and Tissue culture and Pharmaceuticals. The students who enroll for this course will learn several techniques. 10. **MEDICAL LAB TECHNICIAN** - This course offers several techniques concern with diagnosis, treatment and prevention of diseases. The students have job opportunities in Research laboratories and hospitals. This course also provides an excellent avenue for creating entrepreneurs.

• **SATVA – Students And Teachers Value Assimilation**

Value education for holistic development has been an institutional practice over the last ten years. Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women (MLACW) has partnered with DISHA to conduct workshops for enabling holistic development of students' personality in empowering them. DISHA has been conducting workshops for students at the under-graduate level with the main objective of empowering them through facilitating the discovery of their identity. DISHA has also been engaged in conducting Faculty Development Programmes in order to sensitize and enable teaching faculty to mould the character of students and equip them to enjoy all round internal and external harmony and progress.

The workshop methodology is adopted and activity based sessions encourage introspection, create a platform for free and frank discussions, develop a spirit of inquiry, promote creativity, provide exposure to social issues and above all instil a sense of pride in the motherland. The workshop engages students in a perfect blend of activities relating to the head, heart and hands as stated below:

- ✓ Group discussions, quiz and interactive sessions are the activities relating to thinking (the intellectual domain) which form an important aspect of the workshop.
- ✓ Introspection, counselling, storytelling and singing focus upon the emotional component (relating to the heart), that is, feeling that directs behaviour.
- ✓ Yoga, pranayama and games relate to the physical quotient necessary to ensure a healthy mind in a healthy body.

• **PRAGATI**

To meet the challenges in relation to such academic aspects, the teaching and non-teaching faculty must be adequately equipped. Therefore faculty development has become an important aspect in the sustained growth of higher learning institutions. PRAGATI as a practice has been introduced in order to recharge teaching and non-teaching faculty for enabling their personal and professional growth, as well as sustained institutional growth.

Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College for Women has partnered with training organisations to train non-teaching and teaching faculty for capacity building in leadership transition and development, team building, change management and all such skills that will serve as enablers to personal and professional growth.

Workshops are facilitated as in-house or outbound learning programs by facilitators through a process of co-creation which is unique in Indian Higher Education. This is an organizational development process that engages people at all levels in the institution using their collective wisdom to focus on the positive for moving towards a desired future, while addressing the things that need to change so that the image of the future can be realized.

- **College Museum**

The historical museum of the institution was inaugurated on 16th March, 2016. The museum traces the growth of the institution, highlighting important events since its inception in 1972. The museum also houses models of the institution over 4 decades and depicts the milestones of the institution during the period.

- **Research Centres**

Research culture on campus has been promoted by encouraging teachers and students to undertake research. A Research Committee has been formed to oversee and provide impetus to research activity in the institution. The Bangalore University has accorded recognition to the institution for establishing research centres and offering Ph.D. programme in Biotechnology, Kannada language and Commerce. In-house research projects in specific areas and interdisciplinary research is undertaken by students and teachers. Ample opportunities are made available to students and teachers for participating in seminars, conferences and workshops. Facilities such as lab equipment, journals, incentives and sabbatical leave are also provided. Substantial research grants for projects have been received by the institution and 2 major research projects and 15 minor research projects funded by UGC have been undertaken and completed by teachers. Currently there are 17 on-going UGC minor research projects. Grants have also been received for student research projects under the BSR and Star College scheme.
