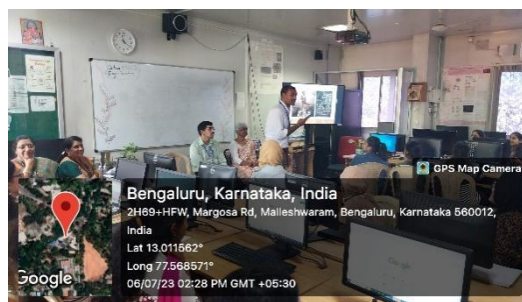
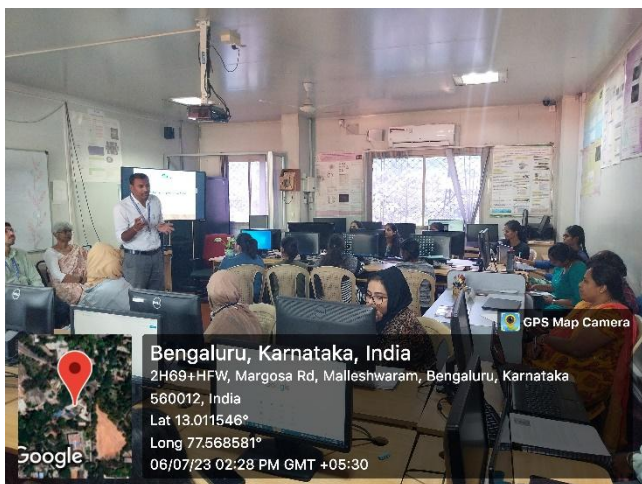
2. Name of the programme: One day hands on workshop cum lecture on “Copyrights Patent and Hands on Prior arts” session.

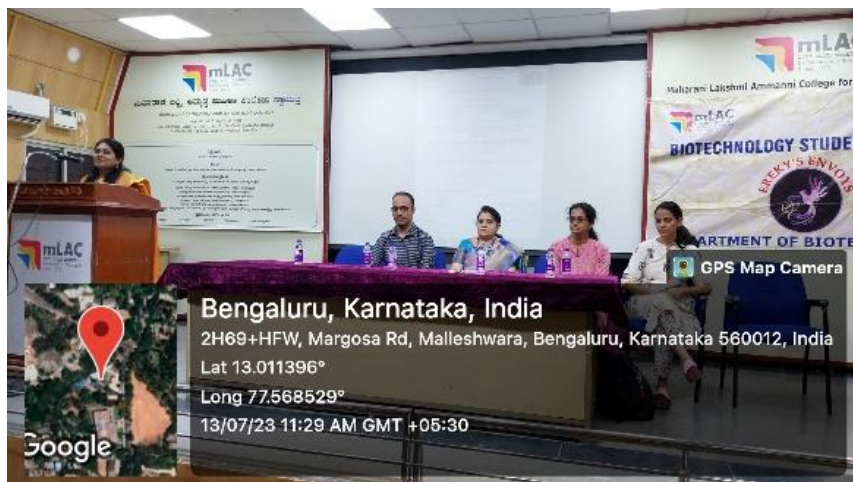
3. Name of the programme: One day hands on workshop on IPR and Entrepreneurship.
