Pulse Polio Campaign- National Immunisation Day 2021

The countrywide Pulse Polio Programme for 2021 began on 31st January, and became popular with name Polio Ravivar. At Rashtrapati Bhawan, President Ram Nath Kovind launched the programme by administering polio drops to children less than five years old. Speaking on the launch of the programme, Union Health Minister Dr Harsh Vardhan proudly said that Polio-free certification of the entire South-East Asia Region of WHO including India on the 27th of March 2014 was a huge accomplishment in the history of India and Global Public Health. However, the Union Health Minister stressed on the need to remain vigilant and maintain the population immunity against polio with sensitive surveillance till global polio eradication happens.

E-Cell Innovia mLAC Students Self-Help Group Initiative, student members volunteered for 4 days Pulse Polio Campaign, organized at UPHC Vidyapeeta ward and joined hands with BBMP Doctors, Nurses, Asha workers, and other NGOs. As E-Cell Cordinator Maharani Lakshmi Ammanni College Autonomous, Dr Abhinandan N. took a lead of motivating students to volunteer for the Pulse Polio Campaign and serve for a noble cause.

Pulse Polio Campaign 2021 was 4 days activity and was spilt as follows:

- > Day 1: Booth activity (31st January 2021)
- ➤ Day 2 to 4: House to house activity (1st February 2021 to 3rd February 2021)

Operational guidelines for National Immunisation Day (NIDs) during Covid 19 included; setting up of separate entry and exit points, wearing mask, sanitization facility, social distancing and avoiding overcrowding to reduce risk of infection.

Several prospective issues which would arise during administering of polio drops were as follows; only 1 drop administered, drops given to sleeping or crying children may run out of mouth, vomiting/coughing out polio drops and finger marking without OPV administration.

Doctor's team and volunteers were briefed on the steps to be taken to avoid any issues arising during administering polio drops. They were made aware of the appropriate questions to be asked to the people at each house, finger marking, filing Booth Tally Sheet, house marking, tally sheet for house to house activity and other reporting formats.

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Report: The session was started by the Ms. Aparna by giving the importance of gardening. A video was played which enlightened about the gardening activities taken place in mLAC in the year 2019-20 by the e- cell faculty members and the students. The welcome speech was given by Ms. Ekta Hotkar and introduced the speaker Ms. Pooja Rai for the day.

The speaker started off her talk by sharing her experience during her college life and has also authored a book on Women Entrepreneurship. She introduced us to Anthill creations and the work taken place there. She gave a complete picture of Anthill creations about their supporters, mentors, play stations, corporate donor and partners, community engagement etc. They actually target on the tyres which is not put to use and use those tyres for making play scapes, play stations, etc. They have around 2,00,000 + children, made 283 playscapes around 18 states. Their playscapes are user centric, diverse activities, sustainable materials are used. They give children an opportunity to come up with innovative ideas in them. She spoke about the 3-fold impact –

- a. **Social**: enabling social, emotional, cognitive and physical development. It stresses on play based interactive learning. It empowers via inclusive community involvement.
- b. **Economic**: direct cost saving due to affordable inputs and designs. It is indirect cost saving related to ease of construction (lighter and quicker). It is an open source designs enabling future replication and scale up.
- c. **Ecological**: sustainability using upcycling and adaptive reuse. To create awareness about importance of recycling.

Few questions were asked by the students like:

- 1. Funding challenges on the way of your creation.
- 2. What is the role of a co-founder?
- 3. Challenges faced as a woman in your career.
- 4. Brief about TEDx experience as a speaker.
- 5. How to overcome the corruption or bribery on our way to success?
- 6. What are the legal issues faced by you in the initial days of you obtaining the document?
- 7. How to handle the situation when we come across a loss or depression on our way to success?



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- 8. Have you taken up any conversion of government bodies dumpyards near residential colonies, if not how to take up considering legal issues?
- 9. Suggestions or advice to go about the student's career in entrepreneurship after their graduation of post graduation.

At last Dr. Abhinandan N told us to take a pledge to protect our environment and thanked the speaker for giving the students the importance of entrepreneurship.
